RELEASE & ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the permission granted to me by San Angelo Claybird Association, I AGREE TO EXEMPT, RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS, SAN ANGELO CLAYBIRD ASSOCIATION, and its independent contractors, agents, and assigns, from any claims or cause of action of any kind, including but not limited to premises liability, product liability, negligent supervision, negligent entrustment or negligence which may be made by me or, on my behalf, my family, estate, heirs, or assigns. FOR LOSS, INJURY, DEATH OR DAMAGE OF ANY KIND TO MY PERSON OR PROPERTY arising out of my presence at or my participation in shotgun sports at the San Angelo Claybird Association. EVEN IF CAUSED OR CONTRIBUTED TO, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF SAN ANGELO CLAYBIRD ASSOCIATION OR SOME DEFECT IN THE PREMISES, UNSAFE MACHINERY, WEAPON OR CONDITION ON SUCH PREMISES.

Further, I understand and acknowledge that shotgun sports involve the discharge of firearms and that there are many hazards and dangers associated with that activity. I understand and acknowledge that San Angelo Claybird Association makes no representation or warranties, expressed or implied, as to the firearms safety training, or knowledge of safe firearms practices of any of the participants. I HEREBY, PERSONALLY ASSUME ALL RISK OF HARM, INJURY, LOSS OR DEATH WHICH MAY BEFALL ME AS A RESULT OF MY PRESENCE AT, OR PARTICIPATION IN, SHOTGUN SPORTS AT SAN ANGELO CLAYBIRD ASSOCIATION, WHETHER SUCH RISKS ARE FORESEEN OR UNFORESEEN.

ASSOCIATION RULES/REGULATIONS

Clay Cars/Personal Utility Vehicles: All Clay cars/utility vehicles must be operated in designated areas only and must be operated in a safe manner, following the rules of operation. Operators must be 18 years of age and hold a valid drivers license. OPERATORS ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGE OR INJURY TO THEMSELVES, THEIR PASSENGERS AND THIRD PARTY PERSONNEL OR PROPERTY THAT MAY OCCUR WHILE DRIVING A CLAY CAR/UTILITY VEHICLE. Insurance is not provided. San Angelo Claybird Association does not have electrical hookups to charge your Clay Cars/Utility Vehicles. Per NSCA rules, only vertical gun racks are allowed. Shoot management has the right to deny Clay Cars/Utility Vehicle operator's privileges at any time. Their decision is FINAL.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: Ear and eye protection must be worn on the course at all times. Ammunition cannot exceed one and one-eighth ounce shot, 2 ¾ inch shell length, 3 ¼ dram equivalent or 7 ½ inch shot size.

Alcohol Policy: Consumption of alcoholic beverages anywhere on Association property prior to or during shooting is strictly prohibited. Additionally, possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on the Trap Range, Skeet Range, 5-Stand or Sporting Clay courses. Violators of these policies will be disqualified from the shoot and removed from the course with no refund from the Association or event sponsor.

Security personnel will strictly enforce these policies.
